Samdariya School of Special Education

In line with its mission, HUDSA established the Samdariya School of Special Education in 2019, located in Dandupur, just 3 km from Chaka, the block headquarters of Yamunapar, Prayagraj.

This school is recognized by the Government of Uttar Pradesh and is dedicated to the education and development of poor and differently-abled children. It focuses on nurturing hidden talents, building discipline and moral values, and connecting students with the mainstream of development.

The local office of HUDSA also operates from within the school premises. After school hours, the premises are utilized to organize various meetings and seminars on topics related to social awareness and



PROGRAMMES IMPLEMENTED

Certain Activities and Achievements

In 2023-24 HUDSA made significant strides toward improving access to quality education for underprivileged children and youth in Prayagraj, UP. Our focus remained on inclusive education, digital literacy, teacher training, organizing seminars and workshops, for social, cultural upliftment and awareness and infrastructure development. This report outlines our achievements, challenges and the impact of our work over the past year.

With its limited resources, the organization has tried to reach out to children from 2 other schools in the area in addition to the Samdariya school it has established itself. In this way, *a total number of 425 poor children have been identified so far in which there are about 210 girls and 24 private school teachers were called to the center and trained.*



A seminar on "Information Technology and Youth Thinking" was organized on April 27, 2023, to commemorate World Intellectual Property Day. Dr. Babulal Tiwari, Member of the Uttar Pradesh Legislative Council, was the Chief Guest, and Dr. Rama Singh, Principal of Arya Kanya Post Graduate College, Allahabad University, presided over the seminar. A large number of professors and scholars participated in the seminar. Dr. Ashok Pandey, Associate Professor of Mathematics at Ewing Christian College, an autonomous institution of Allahabad University, was honoured for his outstanding services. Addressing the youth, Dr. Babulal Tiwari said that the younger generation, with the help of IT, would make India regain its glory as a world leader.

A special seminar was organized on September 5, 2023, to commemorate *Teachers' Day*, in honor of Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan. The Chief Speaker of the seminar, Dr. Mani Shankar Dwivedi, Principal of Motilal Nehru Post Graduate College, said that Dr. Radhakrishnan was a proponent of humanism and integrative education. On this occasion, several teachers were honoured for their outstanding work.





On September 13, 2023, the *festival of Raksha Bandhan*, an important occasion of Indian Sanatan culture, was celebrated in the school. A large number of children participated in the event and learned about the significance of this festival.

On November 8 and 9, 2023, the organization conducted a *two-day health check-up camp*. A team of doctors, including Dr. Rajesh Gurung was present at the camp. Approximately 350 children underwent health examinations during the event. On this occasion, the doctors educated the children about the importance of a disciplined lifestyle and advised them to avoid junk food.



On December 3, 2023, a special lecture was organized on the theme "*Significance of Education*". The Chief Speaker, Dr. Richa Dwivedi, a renowned social worker from Prayagraj, delivered an inspiring lecture, guiding everyone. She emphasized that education is the foundation for success and progress in nation-building. Dr. Mani Shankar Dwivedi, Secretary, welcomed Dr. Richa Dwivedi, and Principal Pushpa Anand presided over the event. A large number of intellectuals, men and women, were present on this occasion.

On March 5, 2024, a *Science Exhibition* was organized to foster scientific thinking and nurture the creative talents of children. The exhibition was inaugurated by IAS Jagriti Awasthi, Sub-Divisional Magistrate of Karchana. She emphasized that such events help develop exploration, creativity, and problem-solving skills in children. Dr. Rama Singh, Principal of Kanya College, affiliated with Allahabad Central University, presided over the event. Renowned journalist Shri P N Dwivedi shared his thoughts as the Special Guest. The exhibition featured around 70 young scientists who showcased 24 innovative models.





On February 28, 2024, a workshop was organized on the theme "*Sanatan Tradition and Innovative Education*". The Chief Speaker, Jagadguru Swami Adhokshajanand Devatiirth, Shankaracharya of Puri, emphasized that the decline of traditional human values is due to the lack of instilling good values (sanskar). He stressed that institutions need to be vigilant about this. Dr. Manishankar Dwivedi, Secretary of the organisation urged the students to embrace innovation and technology. A large number of young people and women from the local area and rural regions participated in the workshop.

The organisation HUDSA is consistently promoting *Yoga* to strengthen children and youth physically, mentally, and spiritually, and to develop a positive mindset. Through various programs in Prayagraj district, people are being made aware of the benefits of Yoga.



The organization celebrates various *National festivals* every year, including independence day (15 August) Republic Day (26 January) Teachers day (5 September) and Children day (14 November) by organising various cultural and social programs. These programs usually held on the school premises, where children participate in competitions and are awarded prizes.

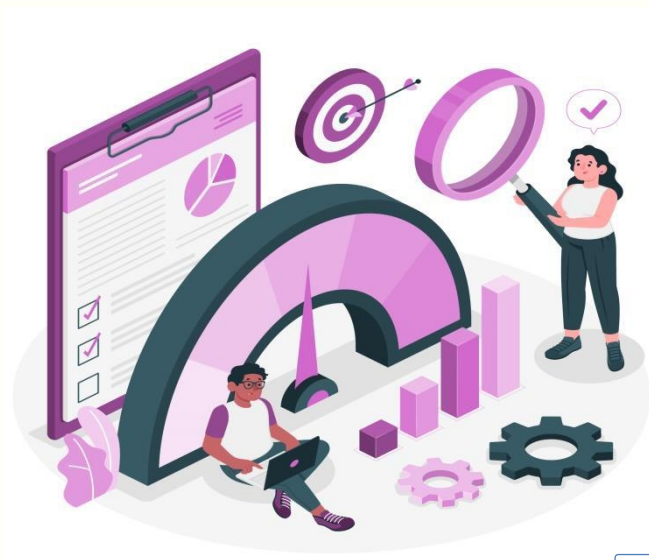
