## Samdariya School of Special Education

In line with its mission, HUDSA established the Samdariya School of Special Education in 2019, located in Dandupur, just 3 km from Chaka, the block headquarters of Yamunapar, Prayagraj.

This school is recognized by the Government of Uttar Pradesh and is dedicated to the education and development of poor and differently-abled children. It focuses on nurturing hidden talents, building discipline and moral values, and connecting students with the mainstream of development.

The local office of HUDSA also operates from within the school premises. After school hours, the premises are utilized to organize various meetings and seminars on topics related to social awareness and



## PROGRAMMES IMPLEMENTED

### *Certain Activities and Achievements*

In 2024-25 HUDSA made significant strides toward improving access to quality education for underprivileged children and youth in Prayagraj, UP. Our focus remained on inclusive education, digital literacy, teacher training, organizing seminars and workshops, for social ,cultural upliftment and awareness and infrastructure development. This report outlines our achievements, challenges and the impact of our work over the past year.

With its limited resources, the organization has tried to reach out to children from 3 other schools in the area in addition to the Samdariya school it has established itself. In this way, *a total number of 500 poor children have been identified so far in which there are about 260 girls and 95 private school teachers were called to the center and trained.*



The organization's efforts is that children from poor families and disabled children from all classes should study together. Learning materials are made available to all children at the primary level. The organization is committed to the sustainable development of poor children. Keeping in mind the need for *digital literacy* in the overall development of children, the organization is continuously making efforts. Last year about 150 children were taught basic computer skills.



Teachers working in private educational institutions are often unfamiliar with innovative education. Realizing the urgent need for their training, the organization is making continuous efforts. This year HUDSA organized 6 teachers training programs in which they were taught the tricks of *inclusive and innovative education*. In this way, about 95 teachers were oriented.





Literary activities have played an important role in the social and cultural development. A huge *Kavi Sammelan* was conducted by the organization on March 30, 2025. Chief guest Uttar Pradesh State Information Commissioner Shri P. N. Dwivedi said that Hindi poems have always been relevant in establishing realization of reality, positive thinking and human values.

In Mahakumbh Nagar, Prayagraj, the district administration allotted land to the organization HUDSA in Shankaracharya Marg, Sector 12. On January 11, 2025 the camp was set up by performing Bhoomipujan in coordination of secretary Dr. Mani Shanker Dwivedi. Through the camp HUDSA organized many seminars for the promotion of Sanatan Culture in the Kumbh area apart from *Yoga practice and meditation*, and *Bhandaras* were also organized.



On December 6, 2024, a seminar on "*Conclave on Diversity of Mahakumbh*" was conducted by the organization. The Chief guest was former Cabinet Minister UP Government and Ex MP Honorable Prof. Rita Bahuguna Joshi and presided over by Uttar Pradesh State Information Commissioner shri P.N. Dwivedi. ## Infrastructure Development

This year, 3 classrooms were constructed in the Samdariya School of Special Education Dandupar run by HUDSA. Prof. Rita Bahuguna Joshi ji MP, Allahabad's MP fund provides Rs 7.00 Lakhs for construction of two classrooms and Shri Surendra Chaudhari ji Legislative council Member, Uttar Pradesh's MLA fund provided Rs. 3.00 Lakhs for construction of one classroom. The remaining Rs 2.40 Lakh for the above construction was spent by the organization its own sources.

In the said school, furniture worth Rs. 30,000 was made for the children to sit. Notice Boards, 6 fans and electrical wiring were provided. Tree plantation and a beautiful garden were prepared for the children.

- ❖ The school and other activities of the organization are being run with the partial support of all the office bearers, members, other donors and poor parents.
- ❖ Collaborated with University / College professors for curriculum development and teachers training.

## Challenges Faced

- \* Lack of essential facilities due to no source of income being



CSR or any other or government.

- \* Shortage of trained teachers in village areas.
- \* Shortage of classrooms, Laboratory, Library and small auditorium.
- \* Lack of smart Boards and computers in the school.
- \* Lack of transport for children in remote areas.

## Plans for Next Year (2025-26)

- Initiative to expand digital learning program at primary level.
- Launch an early childhood education pilot program.

- To start a scholarship program for poor children.
- Classes are being conducted through smart boards in 10 incapable non-government schools.
- Availability of computers in 10 incapable schools.
- Construction of 3 classrooms, Library in Samdariya school of special education.
- Conducting employment oriented skills training programs for youth.
- Self-reliance training programs for women.
- All previous essential activities will continue as usual.
